

Northwestern Academy of Homeopathy is currently accepting applications to its 4-year Academic and Clinical Training Program, which will begin in early 2017. Here is the typical process for admission to NAH.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

1. Candidate attends online info session, visits the school, or talks with admissions office before applying.
2. Candidate completes written application, including two essay questions, and mails application and application fee to NAH: 7104 Lake Street W., St. Louis Park, Minnesota 55426. Application fee is \$100. **Please make check payable to Northwestern Academy of Homeopathy or contact us to pay by credit card.**
3. Candidate requests college transcript(s) be sent directly to NAH: 7104 Lake Street W., St. Louis Park, MN 55426
4. Candidate contacts three separate personal or professional references and instructs each reference writer to send the written reference to NAH: 7104 Lake Street W., St. Louis Park, MN 55426
5. Upon receipt of **all** requested admissions documents, NAH will contact candidate to schedule an admissions interview with a faculty member. Interviews can take place via phone, skype, or in person.
6. Admissions Board reviews application file and interview information.
7. Acceptance/Non-Acceptance letter will be mailed to the candidate.
